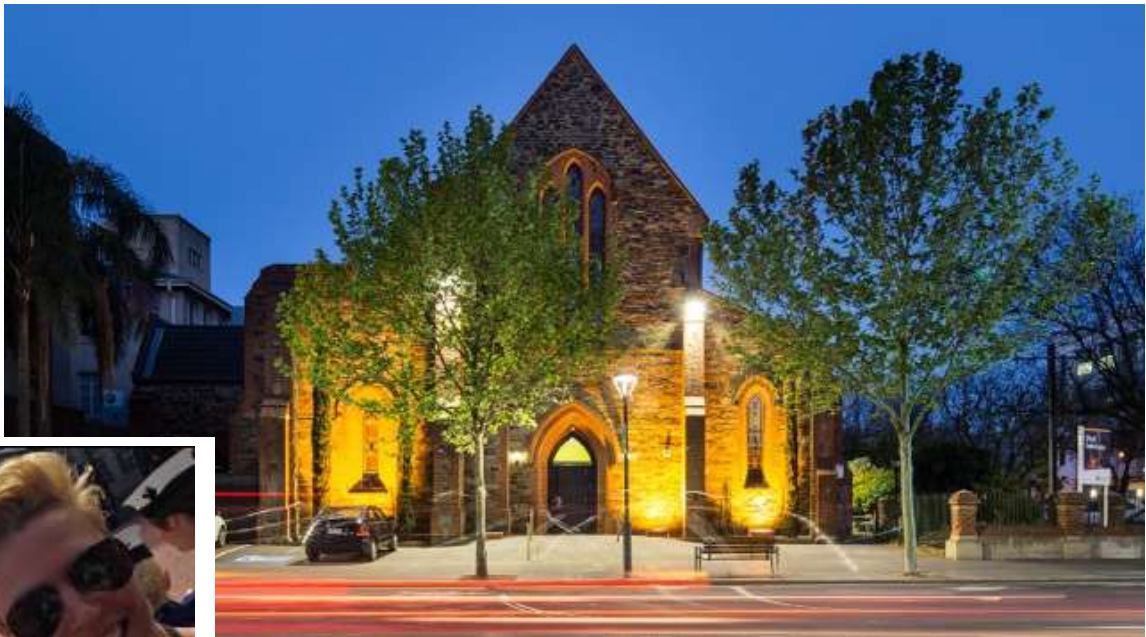

St Paul's Creative Centre is a new co-working space that provides an environment for arts and business incubation and encourages collaboration and connectivity through physical and digital clustering of arts and broader creative industry businesses and practitioners. It's a centre for business skills incubation and mentoring services aligned to the needs of the arts and creative industries sectors and a central location for links to national and international markets, including international trade advice and services.

The Centre offers co-working memberships and open plan office accommodation for the creative industries as a home to Adelaide's music and creative industries. Featuring open-plan working areas, creative spaces, training rooms, private meeting rooms and a stunning function space under the lofty church rafters, St Paul's is a revolving door for the creative community designed for freelancers or start-up or a small business teams.

Community Membership grants are available to give entrepreneurs and creatives full-time membership and access to the centre to start their business. This free membership enables them to build their business and clients and contribute to other creatives businesses.
